

## **Plan for College and Career Readiness (CCR)**

An important part of the Weber High School Comprehensive Counseling and Guidance Program is the Plan for College and Career Readiness (CCR). As a team, the student, parent, and counselor will make a plan that will help the student make the best possible use of their time spent at Weber High.

### **College and Career Readiness Discussion Points:**

Current courses (grades, etc.)  
Next year's course requests  
Academic/Attendance credit make up options  
Testing information – ACT, PSAT, PLAN, SAT, CRT, ASVAB, AP  
Internships and Work-based learning – work and earn credit  
Concurrent Enrollment – earning college credit for classes in high school  
ATC (Applied Technology College)  
Early Graduation  
Early College  
Scholarship Opportunities/Financial Aid  
Alternative education – PM School, Two Rivers, Adult Ed, GED  
University/College Admissions  
Career Information  
Military  
NCAA Clearinghouse – athletes intending to play on the college level

### **COURSE REGISTRATION/SELECTION**

Students at Weber High School will register for 8 classes and 2 alternatives for each semester. Periods 1-4 will be taught on "A" Day and periods 5-8 will be taught on "B" Day. Each class is 90 minutes long. Students will register for the next year's courses during their CCR. Post cards will be mailed home indicating appointment times for sophomore and junior CCRs. **Sophomore CCRs begin the middle of January through February. Junior CCRs begin the middle of November through January. Incoming Freshman will have orientation and registration in January.**

WHS's Course Guide will be posted on this blog and on WHS website at least two days prior to the start of CCRs (Nov). Notifications will be given to students the week before it becomes available. Students and parents are STRONGLY encouraged to go through the course guide and select classes PRIOR to your scheduled CCR appointment.
