- \* On track for graduation (including attendance credit).
- \* No failing grades on preceding report card.
- \* Reliable transportation.
- \* Completion of "Critical Workplace Skills online class for Internships.

- \* Have an Admissions Index of 100+ (Sophomores need 110+).
- \* Have your counselor complete the "High School Counselor Contract."
- \* Meet with Early College Advisor (801-626-8953).

**ASVAB** — Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery. There is no cost for this test. Talk to your counselor to find out testing dates.

**AP Tests** — A series of tests taken upon the completion of an AP class. College credit in the subject area may be earned. Fee required.

Most colleges use your **INDEX SCORE** which is your **GPA** and **ACT** score. Refer to the chart on the right.
