Sign official document with the school before your leave of absence (i.e. mission, military, volunteer).

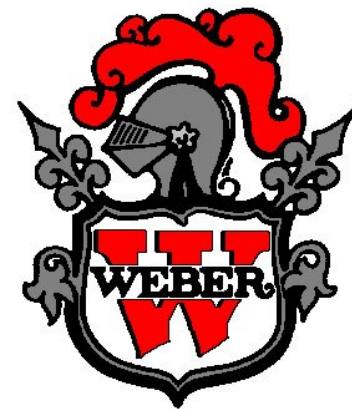
TIPS FOR YOUR SENIOR YEAR

- Work with your counselor and visit the counseling blog frequently. This is where you can access info about college, NCAA, scholarships, financial aid, testing, and much more!
- Clear attendance credit loss. Talk with Mrs. Knight ASAP to get make up information.
- Check with your counselor to verify your graduation status and monitor your credits and attendance frequently.
- Attend ALL classes, ALL the time...don't make the "senioritis" excuse.
- Make college campus visits. Deciding which college to attend is important. Go to the school's website to schedule a campus tour or weekend retreat. Talk to college reps at Post-High Day about taking a tour.
- Request an official transcript be sent to all the schools you apply to. There is a \$1.00 fee for each one sent. Complete the "Transcript Request Form" in the Counseling Office.
- Go to www.utahfutures.org- Good source of college, scholarship, and next-step planning information.

WHS Post-High Day

Tuesday - Sept. 5th, 2017 (8 -10:30 AM)

Priority Admissions/Scholarship Deadlines

December 1st - BYU, Weber State, and U of U.

January 10th - Utah State

*For all other colleges and universities, check websites or consult your College Guidebook (received at WHS Higher Ed Day).

*For need based, diversity, talent, departmental scholarships—consult individual university websites. For talent scholarships (i.e. music, dance, etc.) be sure you know the dates for auditions/portfolios (also available on university websites).

Out of State Admission Deadlines

Out-of-state college application deadlines are *often earlier than Utah schools, and have different requirements*. If you are applying to an out-of-state school, check the website and be aware of deadlines.

ACT Test

October 28, 2017 - Last test to meet priority deadline of Dec. 1st: Register by Sept. 22, 2017

December 9, 2017 - Last test to meet priority deadline of Feb. 1st: Register by Nov. 3, 2017

SAT Test

For students applying to universities outside Utah, that do not accept the ACT, visit www.collegeboard.com for test dates and to register. The SAT is offered at Weber State.

Academic Credit Make-Up

Sign up and start NOW. Talk with your counselor about options. Cost for WHS APEX make-up is \$35/quarter credit. All academic make-up must be turned in by **May 1st** in order to graduate!!!

Attendance Credit Make-up

See Mrs. Knight in the Main Office.

.25 credit loss = 10 hours of community service AND a \$15 fine.

All attendance credit loss must be made up by **May 1st** in order to graduate.

FAFSA

The FAFSA is the FREE application for Federal Student Aid www.fafsa.ed.gov that must be completed for student aid; including federal grants and student loans. You must complete the application by college and state deadlines for maximum awards. You need to have filed your federal and state tax forms (and your parents must do so if you are a dependent) before you can complete the form.

FAFSA application opens October 1st, 2017!
